



Ongoing Request ITRC Project Proposals

- The Interstate Technology and Regulatory Council (ITRC) requests proposals for ITRC projects on an ongoing basis.
- Proposals should be associated with a source of funding or partial funding or proposal authors should have a strong lead for funding sources.
- Project proposals should be submitted using the ITRC Project Proposal Form for Ongoing Projects (<http://www.itrcweb.org/Documents/Planning/2015/ITRC-Project-Proposal-Form-Ongoing.doc>).

- The general process for proposal evaluation and funding is as follows:
 - ITRC receives proposals on an *ad hoc* basis throughout the year
 - Proposals are distributed to the ITRC Board of Advisors for a 2-3 week review period for pre-evaluation
 - ITRC Board of Advisors assess applicability of the proposal to ITRC; States will be surveyed if appropriate
 - ITRC works with proposers and others to secure funding
 - Assemble team and start project
